# WET CARPET EMERGENCY CHECKLIST

## STEP 1: STOP THE SOURCE

- [] Turn off the water (if it's a leak)
- [] Move pets/kids away from the area
- [] Remove nearby furniture or place foil under legs

# STEP 2: BLOT THE AREA

- [] Use towels, press firmly (no rubbing)
- [] Change towels as needed

## STEP 3: EXTRACT MOISTURE

- [] Use wet/dry vacuum if available[] Use wet/dry vacuum if available
- [] If not, keep blotting until only damp

#### STEP 4: DEODORIZE AND DISINFECT

- [] Sprinkle baking soda
- [] Let sit 2-6 hours
- [] Vacuum thoroughly
- [] Spray vinegar + water + essential oil mix

# STEP 5: DRY THOROUGHLY

- [] Open windows
- [] Set fans or a dehumidifier
- [] Avoid walking on it for 24-48 hours

## STEP 6: INSPECT DEEPER ISSUES

- [] Check carpet padding
- [] Lift corners and check for moisture or mold
- [] Replace padding if needed

## STEP 7: DECIDE IF YOU NEED A PRO

- [] Still wet after 48 hours?
- [] Notice a musty smell?
- [] Water from dirty/contaminated source?
- → Call a professional!
